

Searching the database

Users can perform simple searches on a number of different properties and fields, construct complex multiparameter searches, and search by chemical structure.

Structure searches can be performed by converting a text identified to a structure (e.g. SMILES or InChI strings or a chemical name) and also by drawing or modifying a chemical structure using JSDraw or JChemPaint.
