





**Mihály Messinger** was crop-tradesman in Szenc.

**Mariska Messinger** was dental-technician and lived in Kőszeg with her husband.

**József Kolisch** first lived in Nagyfödémes then moved to Pest end worked as candy-maker in *Király utca*. He invested his money, which was the price of a two-storied house, in military-loan. Finally could by nothing on it but a broom and a bucket.

The letter F. in the name of **Elemér F. Antal** stands for *Felsőgelléri*, which is a title of nobility

**Bandi Szamek** was killed in World War I.

**Gusztáv Szamek** was born in 1867 in Nyitra. Went to Törökbecse and worked as lawyer there.

He went to Canada in 1932 after Hermin's death.

**Erzsébet Szamek** was born in 1895 in Törökbecse. Married Sándor Kelen (born Sándor Klein). They moved to Canada in the '20s (Belleville, Ontario) where Sándor worked in the Corby-distillery. After Dezső's death (he died in a car accident while his wife was driving) they moved to Montreal.

**Ignácz Kisch** (father of Kiss Béla György (Bernáth)) was born in 1848 in Óbuda. He was a Hebrew cloth-painter (*kékfestő*). He served for 10 years in the 32<sup>nd</sup> Hungarian Royal-Imperial Regiment as infantryman, than served as soldier in the 63<sup>rd</sup> Regiment. Took part in the campaign of '66 and demobilized in 1876. Later he worked in Óbuda in a cardboard-maker company as painter.

**Béla György** (born Bernáth) **Kiss** was born in 1877 and had 7 siblings. He helped his family, worked as teacher, civil servant. Later he got a university degree in public administration in Kolozsvár and worked as secretary at the stock exchange court. He went into exile to Vienna in 1922. He got divorced in 1913.

**György Szamek** was in prison for his communist views. He left Szeged to Rome, later Bologna than Zurich where he worked as chemist.

**Hugó Szamek** had a motorboat

**Józsa Lővy** (Hugó Szamek's wife) met an earl during the war and went away with him.

**Ilona Szamek** and Jenő Junker lived at Szt. István körút before the I. WW.

**József Rudas** married again in 1991
